

INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS - ELIGIBILITY
-Morse High School-

A. Students participating in co-curricular activities (including managers and statisticians) must maintain passing mid-quarter/quarterly grades in grades 9-12. A student must be enrolled in 6 courses to be eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics. The mid-quarter/quarterly grades shall comply with the following procedures:

1. Any student declared ineligible on a mid-quarter/quarterly check will be ineligible until the next review. A student declared ineligible is ineligible for 10 days. If the grades have not improved, then he/she is dismissed from the activity.
2. During the student's period of ineligibility he/she may practice but not participate in interscholastic activities.
3. In the case of incomplete work due to unavoidable absences, the student may be declared eligible by the athletic director/administrator upon notification of satisfactory completion.
4. Fourth-quarter grades may be made up by attending summer school or by completing a pre-approved tutoring program.

B. Students suspended from school will not be permitted to participate in the interscholastic program until they have been re-admitted.

C. A student is eligible for only eight consecutive semesters after he/she first enrolls as a freshman. In cases of severe illness or extenuating circumstances, the building administrator may apply to the MPA for an extension.

D. A student becomes ineligible on his/her twentieth (20) birthday or upon graduation from high school.

E. If a student's citizenship is poor, the building administrator may declare that student is ineligible.
